- 1. Children must come to school with their masks.
- 2. If a child has a temperature above 37.5 or other symptoms of Covid-19 (cough, sore throat, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, difficulty breathing, cold) they cannot come to school.
- 3. A medical certificate for readmission to school is not required for less than three days of absence. More than three days a certificate is required.
- 4. Each school of the Institute has rules for admission. In all schools, each class has an entrance space. Children must enter with their own class.
- 5. The bell for the beginning of lessons is at 8.00am.
- 6. The class teacher accompanies the children from the entrance to their classroom.
- 7. Jackets must be placed in a shopper bag and hung on the hangers assigned to the class.
- 8. Children must sanitize their hands at the special dispensers at the entrance to school.
- 9. When children are seated at their desk they can lower the mask. As soon as they get up they have to put it back in place.
- 10. Each child must have their own drinking bottle, not plastic bottles.
- 11. During the break the children will go out to the courtyard or to the outdoor spaces assigned to each class. In case of bad weather, the interval is inside, always in spaces assigned for each class.
- 12. On leaving for the break, the classes must stay in their own delimited space.
- 13. Before or during the break, the children have a snack (brought from home).
- 14. Children are not allowed to leave books, notebooks or other personal items at school.
- 15. When, needed each child must have their own personal paper handkerchiefs.
- 16. On exit the same instructions are followed as at the entrance: class by class, accompanied by the teacher.
- 17. If a child experiences symptoms of Covid-19 at school, they will be accompanied to a designated classroom and their parents will be called. The parents must take the child to the pediatrician and follow their instructions. The child can return to school only after having verified that it is not Covid-19 and with a certificate from the pediatrician.
- \* This is a list of the most important instructions for back to school. Another more detailed document specific to the situation is also being sent to the families. The teachers are available to answer any questions the children may have.
