



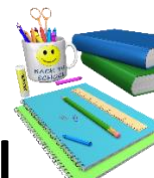

Vademecum middle school

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR A SAFE START

1. Children must come to school with their masks.
2. If a child has a fever above 37.5 or other symptoms of Covid-19 (cough, sore throat, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, difficulty breathing, cold) they cannot come to school.
3. A medical certificate for readmission to school is not required for less than three days of absence. More than three days a certificate is required.
4. The bell will ring at 7.55 to enter the school gates: each section has a different entrance. Sections A and 2E enter from the main gate, while sections B, C and D enter from the side gate where each section is segregated into the space indicated to enter.
5. The third year enter first, then the second and finally the first.

ON THE FIRST DAY BEFORE ENTERING ALL CLASSES WILL ASSEMBLE IN THE MAIN COURTYARD AND ENTER FROM THE OTHER GATE.

6. The class teacher accompanies the students from the entrance to their classroom.
7. It is necessary, upon entering the school, to sanitize hands at the dispensers present at the entrance or in the classrooms.
8. Jackets must be brought to class and placed on the chair.
9. All other material and personal items must be kept at your desk.
10. When the children are sitting at their desks' they can lower their mask. As soon as they get up they have to put it back in place.
11. Each child must have their own drinking bottle, not plastic bottles.
12. The children at the break go out to the courtyard or to the outdoor spaces assigned to each class. In case of bad weather, the interval is inside, always in spaces assigned for each class.
13. Classes, when they leave for the break, must stay in their own indicated space.
14. Before or during the break, the children have a snack (brought from home).
15. Children are not allowed to leave books, notebooks or other personal items at school.
16. When, needed each child, must have his own personal paper handkerchiefs.
17. There are specific rules for access to the bathrooms.
18. On exit the same instructions are followed as at the entrance: class by class, accompanied by the teacher.
19. If a child experiences symptoms of Covid-19 at school, they will be accompanied to a designated classroom and their parents will be called. The parents must take the child to

the pediatrician and follow their instructions. The child can return to school only after having verified that it is not Covid-19 and with a certificate from the pediatrician.

* This is a list of the most important instructions for back to school. Another more detailed document specific to the situation is also being sent to the families. The teachers are available to answer any questions the children may have.
